

## **Bridgman Bowls Club, Harold 100 Club Rules**

1. The object of the Club is to raise funds for the running and upkeep of Bridgman Bowling Club.
2. The Club will be run under the supervision of BBC committee.
3. The Club is open to all members of the club as well as family, friends and local residents.
4. Members must be 16 or over.
5. Members will have to fill in an application form
6. Entry to monthly draws will be by subscription of £5 per month per number, paid in advance, preferably by Standing Order on the basis of a minimum period of twelve months (£60 per number per annum).
7. Members may have more than one number.
8. The Club will not be limited to 100 members.
9. Subsequent to the first draw in December 2020, additional new members will be entered for the draw in the calendar month that follows the receipt of the first monthly payment. Responsibility for ensuring that the subscription has been paid rests with the individual members, not BBC.
10. The draw will be monthly, to take place in most cases at the BBC committee meeting. If this does not take place, it will be drawn in the presence of three BBC members.
11. Names of winners will be posted on BBC notice board, website and emailed out to all members after each draw.
12. There will be three prizes each month. The prize fund will be 50% of the monthly income. Below is an example of 100 members:

1 <sup>st</sup> prize:	£125	(50% of the monthly Prize fund)
2 <sup>nd</sup> prize:	£75	(30%)
3 <sup>rd</sup> prize:	£50	(20%)

The remainder of the fund will be allocated to BBC.
13. Registers will be kept recording the name and address of each members, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the Club if his or her renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month.
15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into BBC funds after 6 months.
16. The decision of BBC committee shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication.
17. BBC committee shall have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 100 Club members as is necessary.
18. Your personal data will not be passed on to any other person or organisation.
