RULES FOR COMPETITIONS

ALL GAMES TO BE PLAYED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE **ENGLISH BOWLING ASSOCIATION**.

THE COMPETITOR APPEARING FIRST IN EACH PAIRING SHALL BE THE CHALLENGER. THE CHALLENGER SHOULD CONTACT THEIR OPPONENT TO ARRANGE A DATE TO PLAY. HOWEVER IF THE CHALLENGER FAILS TO CONTACT THEIR OPPONENT THE OPPONENT SHOULD OUT OF COURTESY CONTACT THE CHALLENGER AT LEAST ONE WEEK BEFORE THE CLOSING DATE OF THAT ROUND.

IF A GAME IS NOT PLAYED BY THE DUE DATE THE OPPONENTS NAME WILL GO FORWARD TO THE NEXT ROUND.IN SOME EXTREME CASES SHORT EXTENTIONS MAY BE GRANTED E.G. ILLNESS (CONTACT COMPETITON SECRTARY).

ALL GAMES SHOULD BE PLAYED TO THE CONCLUSION E.G. 18 ENDS OR 21 SHOTS AS IN **E.B.A.**

DEAD ENDS ARE REPLAYED AND NO SCORE.

IF THE SCORE IS LEVEL AFTER THE SET NUMBER OF ENDS AN EXTRA END SHALL BE PLAYED .TOSS FOR THE JACK.

WINNING PLAYER TO ENTER THEIR NAME ON THE SHEET FOR THE NEXT ROUND.

SUBSTITUTES MAY BE USED EXCEPT IN SINGLES, SUBSTITUTES MAY NOT SKIP.
